Previous assignments include; Cannoneer in the 1/321 AFAR, Ft Bragg, NC, Personal Security Officer for the 82nd Airborne Division Command Group, FT Bragg, NC Ammo Team Chief in the 1/319th AFAR, Ft Bragg, NC. SGT Flynn has had two tours in Afghanistan and has been awarded five Army Commendation Medals, five Army Achievement Medals, Senior Parachutist Badge, and the Combat Action badge.

Since learning to skydive in 2008 he has logged more than 400 free fall parachute jumps, and 50 military static line jumps.
