Throughout his career duty stations have included Schofield Barracks, Hawaii, Yongsan, Korea, Walter Reed Army Medical Center, Washington, D.C., and Fort Meyer, Virginia as a Senior Medic with 4/3 INF. In 2012 SGT Severin attended the rigorous Golden Knight Assessment and Selection Program and was Knighted to become a member of the Black Demonstration Team.



SGT Ken Severin has served one tour in Afghanistan, and two tours in Iraq. He has been awarded the Army Commendation Medal, the Army Achievement Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, The Afghanistan Campaign Medal, the Iraq Campaign Medal, and the Army Good Conduct medal.
