Sergeant Daniel Cook is a 15S, Kiowa Crew, chief serving as a Demonstration Parachutist with the Black Team.

After enlisting into the Army in October of 2003, Cook was assigned to the 82nd Airborne Division of Fort Bragg, NC. In July of 2006 he deployed to Iraq with the 17th Cavalry regiment for a period of 12 months.



In 2007 Cook chose to attend the Golden Knight Assessment and Selection Program, which is used by the Knights to assess young skydivers' skills and evaluate their team working abilities.

Cook Started jumping in September of 2004 and has since logged more than 2,800 freefall parachute jumps, and 15 military static line jumps.

When he is not traveling and performing with the Team Daniel Cook enjoys Tennis, Ping Pong, RC Aircraft, mountain biking and spending time with his kids.
